Headteacher's Update

We have had yet another busy week at school. It started with Monday's Celebration Assembly and it was fabulous to hear from all the teachers that our pupils have such a positive attitude to their learning.

Clubs have started this week and there is a huge range on offer to meet the variety of interests that children may have. It was great to hear the children describing the fun that they had at windsurfing and watching the focus of pupils during sketch club. I'm excited to follow pupils skills and confidence growing as they tackle new learning.

There was an air of excitement in school Wednesday morning as our year 6 pupils left for their three day residential to Osmington Bay. For some children this is their first experience of being away from home, we're not sure who were the most nervous, parents or children!!

All the staff continue to explore new opportunities to excite pupils' learning and this week Miss Locke worked with Dorset Cultural hub to explore joint projects with Poole Museum and Warner Film Studios.

Children's University

Last week, we were pleased to welcome Sarah Smith into school to re-launch the Children's University at Bearwood. All Key Stage Two children have a passport and are able to earn learning hours that allow them to graduate at Bournemouth University at the end of Year Six. We are very fortunate to be one of only five local schools who are running the Children's University. It opens up fantastic learning opportunities for our children.

Bournemouth University regularly hold exciting learning events at the weekends and in the holidays. During the last year they have organised puppetry, drama and crazy creature workshops to name but a few! During this year there will be opportunities for our KS2 to visit the campus to participate in learning activities and the BU Student Ambassadors will be coming in to school to run after-school workshops.

The children were very excited during the assembly and I am hopeful that this year we will see many children embracing the opportunities that the Children's University presents. Marvellous Me

After another busy week in school, we hope you have enjoyed the 'Marvellous Me' insights in to your child's learning. We now have 79% of parents signed up. Did you know there is a simple way to share your child's Marvellous Me information between family members? By tapping in the 'Settings' option and then tapping 'Share your app', you can enter the email address of the person you would like to share with. The app then sends an email with a link to the app and your child's unique join code, so they can instantly start seeing receiving the Marvellous Me messages. Times Tables at Bearwood

At Bearwood, we are aiming for children to develop quicker recall of multiplication and division facts and encouraging children to become more enthusiastic about learning their times tables. The 2014 National Curriculum states that, 'by the end of year 4, pupils should have memorised their multiplication tables up to and including the 12 multiplication table.'

Learning multiplication facts does not have to be boring and repetitive; at school we will be encouraging the children to recall facts in different ways through games, challenges and investigations as well as a times table quiz that will be held regularly in each class.

During the weekly times table quiz, if the children are able to prove that they know their current times tables well then they will earn a times table WRISTBAND to keep. They can collect these wristbands all the way up to the 12x tables. These will be celebrated in assembly on a Monday.

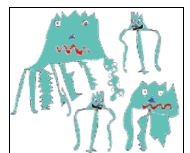
We hope that you will join us in supporting your child to learn these important facts in order for them to make rapid progress in their maths learning.
