Marvellous Me

Last year we shared a high number of messages with 98% of our parent community. This year we will be continuing to use this messaging system to send you positive messages about your child's learning and achievements. We also use Marvellous Me to communicate important reminders. **Perhaps most importantly, we send out information if your child is being celebrated in Assembly.** If your child is to be celebrated, you will receive a message by the end of the Friday before. For Key Stage Two children, information about Children's University is sent out in this way.

We are aiming to have 100% of parents using Marvellous Me this year. To ensure the app is effective, please check you have an up-to-date version via the App Store and have selected to receive notifications. If you are having issues, please reinstall the app. When reinstalling, you do not need your original join code, just your email and password that you used when you created your account.
