Our Jigsaw topic this half term is 'Celebrating Difference'. We will be recognising that we are all different, learn how to include others and talk about the importance of using kind words.

Phonics

Oak One will be working on clapping and tapping rhythms on our bodies and on instruments. We will be developing an understanding of alliteration and rhyming words.

Oak Two will be revising the individual sounds learnt in term 1. We will be working on blending cvc words containing these sounds. Those who are ready will also be writing short sentences including the tricky words—the, and, to ,go, no and I.

Reading

We will all be learning 'The Enormous Turnip' as a talking story. Oak One will be working on describing, settings, events and characters in stories. We will be working on retelling stories in order.

Oak Two will continue to read with an adult at least once a week. The focus will be on reading cvc words containing the sounds they have learnt.

Physical Development

Oak One will be introduced to 'Write Dance' and will mark make to music. We will focus on holding a pencil correctly. Oak Two will focus on holding their pencils correctly and on anti clockwise movements and retracing vertical lines.

Maths

Oak One are learning to recite number names in order to ten and comparing two sets of objects saying when they have the same number. Oak Two are working on counting objects up to 10 and beyond 10. Focussing on identifying teen numbers. Through our topic we will be ordering 2 items by weight or capacity.

Expressive Art and Design

Exploring the Farm Shop and Hospital role play corners.

We will be learning to mix our paint colours and access a range of materials and tools in preparation for Christmas craft.

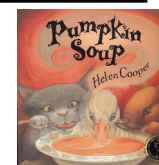
