Our Jigsaw topic this half term is 'Healthy Me'. We will be learning about making healthy food choices and the importance of sleep and exercise in keeping fit and well.

Phonics

Oak One will be working on hearing rhyme in words and creating strings of rhyming words. We will be learning about alliteration e.g. dizzy dinosaur, crazy cat, little lizard.

Reading/ Writing

We will all be learning 'The Three Little Pigs' as a talking story.

We will be reading "There's a monster in my book" and 'The Gruffalo' and discussing the fact that monsters are not real.

We will be creating story maps of our rip to Farmer Palmers and creating our own talking story as a class with actions. Oak 2 will be using these to write simple recounts.

Oak 2 will be beginning to form simple sentences, using capital letters, fingers spaces and full stops.

Understanding the World

We will be...

Role playing in our new café outside, making our own menus and food.

Learning to match animals with their babies and talk about how they grow and change.

Learning the Easter story and talking about how and why Christians celebrate. We will be making Easter crafts.

Maths

We will be developing our use of time language (e.g. first, next then) and ordering events. We will also be able investigating how we can use timers. We will be exploring and creating our own patterns.

Oak One will be investigating different ways of splitting groups of objects to realise that the total stays the same. We will be working on representing numbers through drawings and numerals.

Oak Two are going to be counting irregular arrangements of objects reliably. They will be beginning to estimate the number of objects they can see and check by counting.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be learning to mix our own paint colours and exploring how to create different shades. We will be exploring how to use different sized brushes to create different effects and learning how to choose the right brush for the outcome we want to achieve.
