Phonics

Oak One will be working on hearing the first sound in a word and learning about alliteration e.g. clever cat, daring dog, hungry horse.

Maths

Oak One will be learning to recognise numbers and how to represent numbers in different ways. We will be working out counting objects reliably. We will be learning number rhymes to share with parents in Family Rhyme Times.

Oak Two are beginning to use everyday language related to money. We will be working on developing our understanding of halving and sharing. We will be revising positional language. We will be working on recording maths problems through pictures and symbols.

Reading/ Writing

We will all be learning 'We're Going On A Bear Hunt' as a talking story and adapting it to creating our own versions. We will use instruments to add sound effects.

Oak 1 will be working on creating their own stories, talking about characters and settings.

Oak 2 will be beginning to form simple sentences, using capital letters, fingers spaces and full stops. We will be completing reading Phase 3 sounds and focusing on using them in our writing. Children will be writing independently to reflect on their 'Planning Time' each day.
