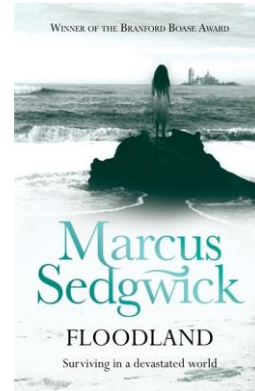




**English:**

**Geography:**

**Locational Knowledge:**  
This half term we will be using maps and atlases to locate U.K cities and counties. We will learn how the environment has impacted on the location of these cities by exploring the importance of rivers.

**Physical geography:**  
We will also be looking at mountains, earthquakes and volcanoes.

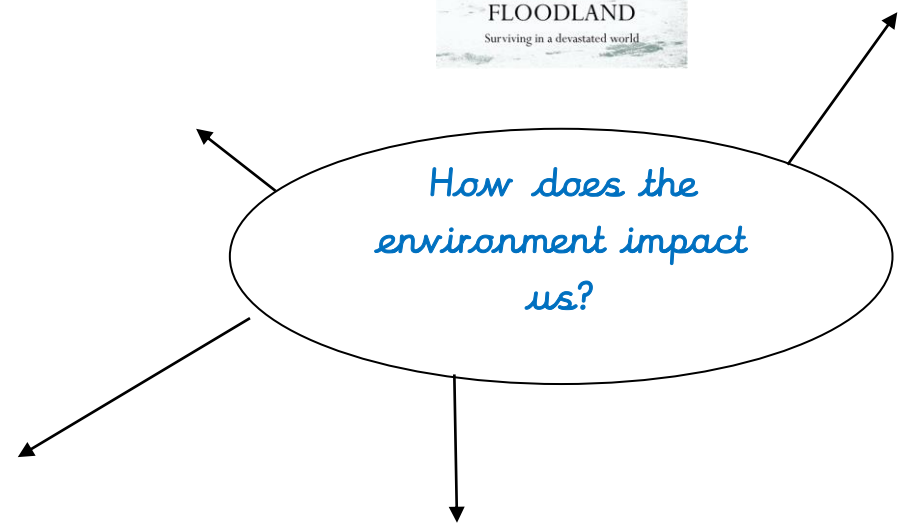
This will involve, looking at how they are made and the impact they have on humans.
