Our Jigsaw topic this half term is 'Changing Me'. We will be thinking about moving to our new classrooms, talking about how change makes us feel and getting excited about all the new things ahead!

Phonics

Oak One will be working on segmenting and blending simple words. We will continue to work on hearing the initial sounds in words.

Oak Two will be revising all learnt sounds and reading and writing these sounds in longer words such as 'lunch box' and 'train track'.

We will be embedding phase 3 graphemes to promote fluency in reading words which need sounding out.

Tricky Words:

Read: said, so, have, like, some, come, were, there, little, one, do, when, out, what

Reading/ Writing

We will all be sharing the story of 'Handa's Surprise'. Handa is a little girl from Africa .

Oak 1 will be working hard on mark making this term. We will be experimenting with different tools and materials from charcoal and chalks to gloop. We will work on forming letters from our names and talking about our pictures.

Oak 2: In reading we will continue to learn phase 4 tricky words and phase 5 for children who are ready. We will be building up fluency of reading by exploring more text which have a mixture of phonics and sight vocabulary.

In writing we will be writing our own stories like Handa's surprise and using all our skills to independently write simple sentences.

Understanding the World

We will be...

Learning about different types of travel. We will be finding out some facts about Africa and learning about some of the animals and food.

Role playing in our shop role play area, using real money to buy fruit and vegetables.

Creating tents and dens in our deconstructed role play area.

Investigating different types of fruit, cutting them up and tasting them .

We will be having a visit from the RNLI to talk about water safety and their job.

Making the most of the warmer weather to experiment and investigate with water.

Maths

Oak One will be continuing to focus on counting objects reliably and recognising digits. We will be working on developing confidence with shapes and talking about how we have used them in our work.

Oak Two will be subtracting and adding 2 groups using larger numbers and using a numberline to count on and back. We will be comparing different measures and thinking how to solve a problem to make something bigger/smaller/the same. We will also be looking at counting out larger numbers and introduce the terms ones and tens.

Expressive Art and Design

This half term will focus on using junk modelling materials to create our own transport models. We will be designing and then using our cutting and joining skills to bring our ideas to life.


