Maths

Oak One are learning to say number names in order to ten and beginning to count out objects accurately.

Oak Two are working on recognising numbers to 20 and counting objects to 10 and beyond. We will be investigating how many different ways we can make each number to 10.

We will be sorting according to size and grouping objects, linking with our work on 'The Three Bears'.

Phonics

We will be learning lots of traditional nursery rhymes to support awareness of rhyme.

Oak One will be developing an awareness of environmental sounds and working to develop rhythm.

Oak Two will be focusing on hearing initial sounds in words and learning individual sounds in the following sets;

Week One: s, a, t, p

Week Two: l n m d

Set Three: g, o, c, k

Week Four: ck, e, u, r

Week Five: h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss

Reading

We will be learning the story of 'The Three Bears' as a talking story and retelling the story in our own words. We will be talking about characters and settings. In our role play, we will be exploring the events of the story through imaginative play. All children will be encouraged to bring home a bedtime reading book to share with you at home. These can be changed daily as you enter the cloak-room.

All children will visit the Library every Friday. After a few weeks of learning sounds and tricky words, Oak Two children will also be bringing home a coloured book banded book to read with you at home.

Understanding the World

We will be thinking about different types of families and talking about who is in our own family. We will be learning about celebrations within the family, looking at birthdays. We will also be talking about our likes, dislikes, interests and hobbies.

We will be learning to use tablets to take photos and looking at how toys work.

Physical Development

We are working on developing a correct pencil grip and mark make with meaning. Oak Two will be beginning to form recognisable letters.

We will be having 'dough discos' to develop our hand strength.
