Our Jigsaw topic this half term is 'Healthy Me'. We will be talking about foods that keep us healthy as well as thinking about why we need to get lots of sleep and exercise.

Phonics

Oak One will be working on hearing the initial sounds in words through using sound bags .

Oak Two will be revising all phase 3 sounds and practise identifying them in words when reading and writing. We will move on to hearing all the sounds in cvcc and ccvc words (tent, milk and stop).

We will be learning to spell I , to, go, into, the, no, he, she, we and me.

Maths

Oak One are learning to recognise numbers to 10 and represent these in different ways.

We will start to write these numbers.

Oak Two are working on counting objects beyond 10 and focussing on identifying teen numbers. We will also focus on learning addition facts for 6, 7, 8 and 9. For example

$$3+3=6$$

$$2+4=6$$

Reading

As a base we will be learning the story of Jack and The Beanstalk as a talking story. We will be reading a variety of non fiction texts about animals and different animal homes.

Oak 2 will be revising the reading of the words: he, we, she, me, be, they, all, was, you. We will be learning to read the words: said, so, do, have, some, come, like, were, and do. We will be using our phonic sounds to read ccvc / cvcc words.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be challenging the children to make animal homes out of different materials . We will investigate different joining techniques and use a variety of split pins and ties.
