Twinkl.com is a site online which has a wealth of games and power points which support your child's learning. Whilst the school is shut, you as parents, can access this site and use the resources.

Each child in Oak 1 and Oak 2 will be bringing home a bean or sunflower seed to plant at home. It would be helpful if children could keep a diary of any changes that happen.
