- Work closely as a team to share children's learning progress.
- Send weekly, online, personalised home learning in maths, reading and writing based on learning from the previous week.

Parents will:

- Encourage children to complete all home learning set, such as Spelling Shed assignments, Times Table Rockstars practice and specific writing tasks.
- Read regularly with children and record in reading record.

Pupils will:

- Try your hardest at school and home with your learning.
- Complete home learning given to you by your teachers.
- Read at home regularly with someone at home.
- Practise times tables regularly at home.
