



Wear the correct uniform:


- Be proud to be part of the Bearwood School Team.

ENGAGEMENT -TIMES TABLES

- It is vital that children are fluent with their times tables up to 12X12. They need to know them inside out, upside down and back-to-front (including division facts).
- Times Table Rockstars and Maths Shed is a great resource to use and it really does help children learn their tables when used regularly. Regular practise is essential to maintaining speed of recall.
