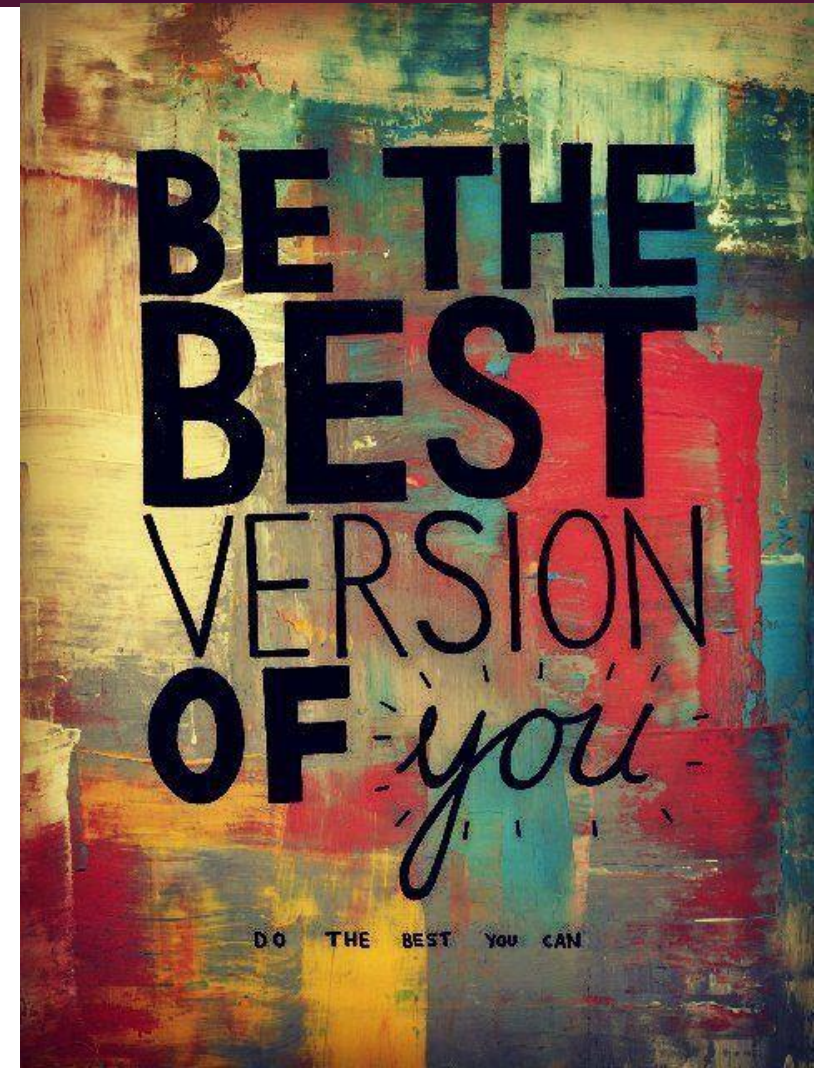


Absence from School

Children are required to attend school for 190 days each year

Attendance during one school year	equals days absent	which is approximately weeks absent	Which means this number of missed lessons
95%	9 days	2 weeks	45 lessons
90%	19 days	4 weeks	95 lessons
85%	29 days	6 weeks	145 lessons
80%	38 days	8 weeks	190 lessons
75%	48 days	10 weeks	240 lessons
70%	57 days	11.5 weeks	285 lessons
65%	67 days	13.5 weeks	335 lessons

ENGAGEMENT – BE PREPARED

Wear the correct uniform:

- *Be proud to be part of the Bearwood School Team.*
- *Especially TIES and BLACK SHOES.*
- *No makeup (including nail varnish) or jewellery.*

Bring the correct kit:

- *Reading record and book to be brought in DAILY.*
- *Come to school in PE kit on PE days (to be communicated once liaised with sports coaches) .*
- *PE kit consists of:*
 - *Purple or white T shirt, black shorts; tracksuit for the colder weather; trainers.*
- *Ear piercings can be covered with tape for the first 6 weeks after piercing - otherwise earrings need to be removed for PE, and hair should be tied back.*

each day
900 minutes
in a school year.

Child "C"
reads **1 minute**
each day
180 minutes
in a school year.



ENGAGEMENT – TIMES TABLES

- It is vital that children are fluent with their times tables up to 12X12. They need to know them inside out, upside down and back-to-front (including division facts).
- Times Table Rockstars and Maths Shed is a great resource to use and it really does help children learn their tables when used regularly. Regular practise is essential to maintaining speed of recall.
