
SPOT IT

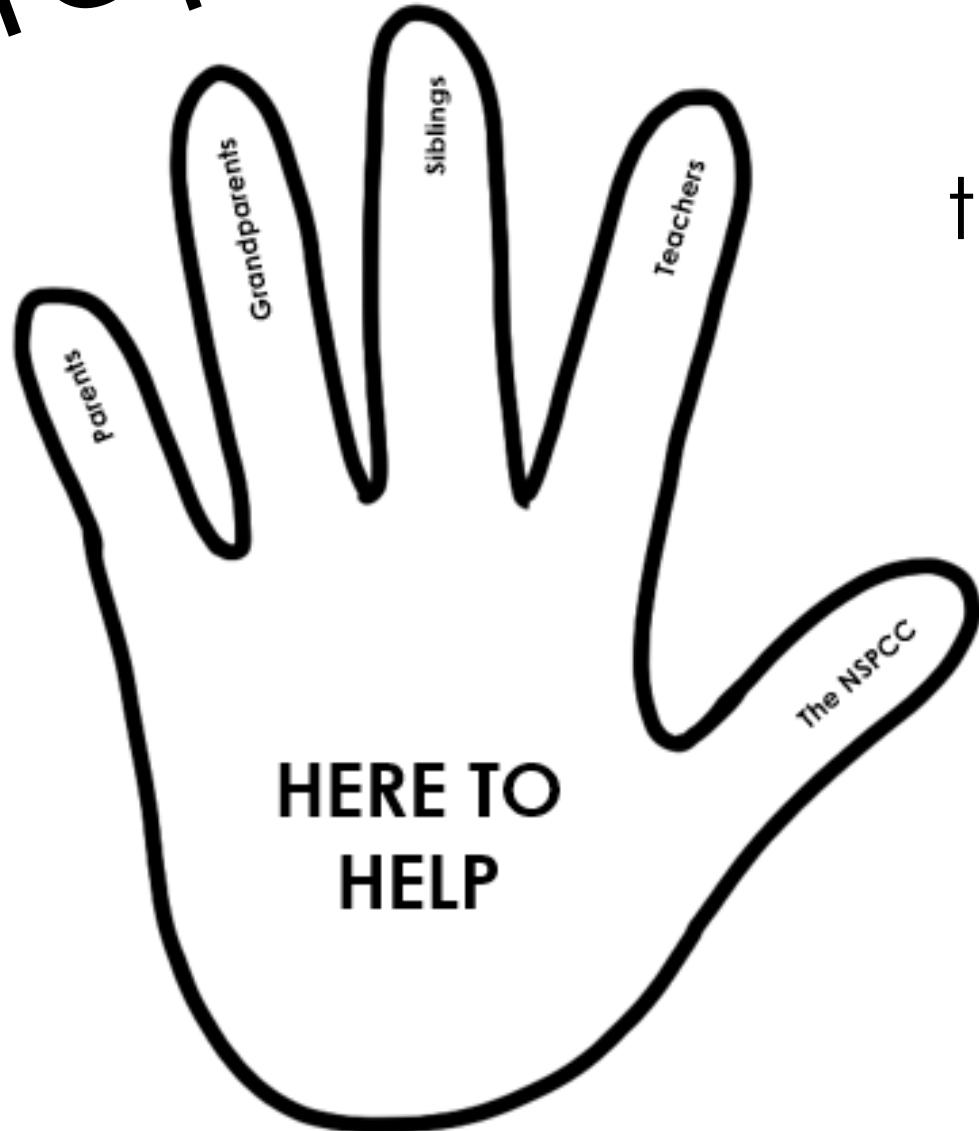
