## Headteacher's Update

This week has been a great start to the half term, with the children taking part in different events across the week. Abi from Arts 2 Educate came in and lead a workshop with each class where every child created a piece of artwork to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee. It was fantastic to see the children enjoying these activities and being proud of what they had created. Year 5 and 6 also had a visit from the Safer Schools Community Team which focussed on anti-bullying. The children learnt about the different types of bullying and the laws around this. Every class has also taken part in a fun and interactive Life Base workshop, which focussed on the importance of physical and emotional health. It's been fantastic to be able to welcome visitors into school again.

## Key Stage 2 BSO Performance

On Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> May, the children in key stage 2 went to the lighthouse in Poole to watch a performance from the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra called 'Midnight Magic'. As well as enjoying listening to the orchestra perform some wonderful compositions, they also got to take part themselves. They had worked hard to learn a song that was specially composed for the performance and joined in with singing, Makaton actions and body percussion, performing so confidently on the day. Well done to all of the children!

**Visit from Life Education**

This week all classes have enjoyed a workshop from Life Education. Children in KS1 learnt about keeping their bodies healthy, managing feelings, being a good friend and the safe use of medicines. Children in KS2 explored emotional needs, choices that can affect health and wellbeing, qualities of friendship and how to cope with bullying and the influence of friends and peer pressure.
