Head Bump Notifications - Marvellous Me App

From this week we will be notifying parents via the Marvellous Me App if they have bumped their head whilst at school. Children will still receive a 'bumped head' sticker to notify all adults within the school.

If a bumped head is deemed a serious head injury then you will be contacted via a phone call and if required, you will be asked to collect your child.

RNLI Water Safety Update

As you may be aware with the summer holidays ending, the number of lifeguarded patrolled beaches along the sea front have been reduced. We continue to encourage those going to the coast to swim at a lifeguarded beach - in between the Red and Yellow Flags. It's important that children in particular swim under supervision. Current local BCP beaches with lifeguards patrolling 10.00 – 18.00 until 24th September are:

Boscombe East Beach
Bournemouth East Beach
Bournemouth West Beach West Cliff
Sandbanks

Water is unpredictable, 4 things all children need to consider when visiting open water locations:

- STOP AND THINK what dangers can you see? Water and wind conditions, including depth and movement
- STAY TOGETHER Don't be caught out on your own. Carry a phone to call for help.
- FLOAT If you fall in, stay calm and Foat to Live.
- Someone in trouble? CALL 999 OR 112 and tell them that someone's in the water. Never jump in after them. Look for something you can throw to help them float like a lifering or a football.
