

# Holly 2 Curriculum Newsletter - Autumn 2




We hope you had a great half term. This newsletter is to let you know about all of the exciting things that the children will be learning in Holly 2 over the next half term.

# **English**

This half term we are studying Traditional tales and will be looking at alternative versions of Jack and the beanstalk. We will also be learning through

a John Lewis Christmas
Advert. In our reading
lessons we will be concentrating on the skills of inference, retrieval and prediction to deepen our understanding of the texts.
During our writing lessons we will be creating character descriptions and writing our own version of the story.



We are also focusing on structuring our sentences correctly and including a wider range of punctuation.

I'm sure the children will be talking to you about our work.

### SPaG

Holly 2 will receive daily Phonics, spelling, grammar and punctuation sessions.



### ICT

In our ICT lessons we will learn how to use email safely and responsibly and we will also have to solve the mystery of the stolen cake! "Children have the right to an education that should develop each child's personality, talents and abilities to the fullest."

## Geography

In geography we will be able to name and locate the capital cities of the UK. We will explore the differences between the capitals. We will also learn about how population effects the pollution.



### Maths

In maths we will begin our learning on addition and subtraction with 2 digit numbers. We will also learn about 2d and 3d shapes.



In art we will focus on Painting. We will explore tertiary colours and how to make them.



# Reading

Children who enjoy reading regularly thrive in their learning and therefore children are reading with adults 3 times a week. The book they are reading will then be sent home to increase their fluency.

Please ensure the books are returned on the Wednesday.



We will have 2 PE lessons every week so please ensure that your child has their full PE kit in school every day. Please also ensure that their PE kit is fully named.

Children who have recently had their ears pierced should cover them with tape, but once they have healed they must not wear earrings for any PE lessons. Please provide your children with tape and show them how to use it as we are not able to help with this.

This half term we will be working on "Sending and receiving" and "Net and wall" skills.

### Curriculum Enrichment

This half term we will have Forest School every Friday. Please ensue your children bring in warm clothes every week as Forest School will go ahead no matter what the weather is! They will need to come to school in uniform and we will get changed in class. (wellies are a good idea)



### PSHE

The children will be following the PSHE programme of study, Jigsaw. This half term the focus is "Celebrating Difference".

Our World View this half term is Christianity and we will explore this by learning about Incarnation.

### Music

In Music this half term we will focus on exploring simple patterns
