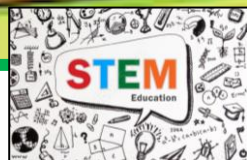
Throughout the year, different sporting coaches develop our skills and knowledge of physical activity in **PE**.

We finish the year learning about 'Animals'. We visit Moors Valley to learn about pond life and minibeasts. (£9.80) **UTW Focus**



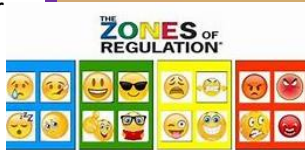
Autumn

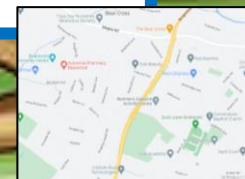
Year One

For **History**, Poole museum will visit the school so we can learn about pirates and Harry Paye.



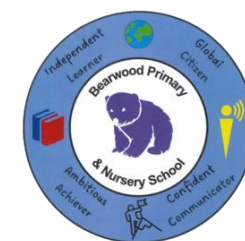
Autumn

We are actors in the school nativity. We perform, dance and sing in front of an audience. This helps develop our skills as confident communicators.

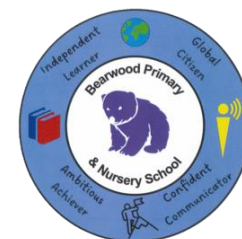


We learn about conserving water. We have a workshop from Waterwise in our **Science** lessons.

In **PE**, we develop our football knowledge and skills through working with AFC Bournemouth coaches.



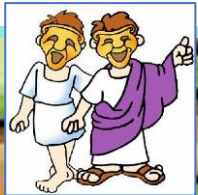
For **Science** and **Geography** we walk to Canford SANG in search of animals and their food chains.

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Curriculum Enrichment

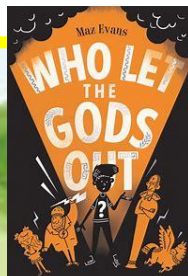
As part of our **Computing** curriculum, we take part in Dorset Coding Day which involves learning about careers in the digital sector and how to code a game.
