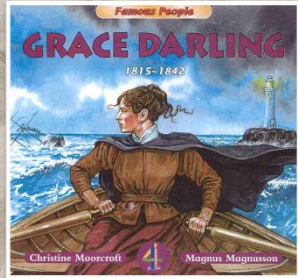


History

Enrichment and Home learning

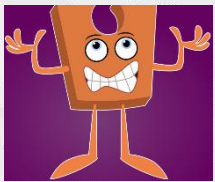
