English

Boy in the Tower English:

This half term. English will be delivered through the text 'Boy in the Tower' by Polly Ho-Yen. Through this unit, the children will learn and revise many of the key punctuation and grammar requirements including the use of colons, semicolons, hyphens and dashes. We will look at the difference between formal and informal language including writing a formal letter. They will also have the opportunity to apply them within short and longer writing outcomes linked to the text.

Science

This unit will focus on 'Evolution and Inheritance.' The children will begin by understanding characteristics are passed on to an offspring and how this can lead to variation. We will also research how our understanding of evolution has developed, including learning about Charles Darwin.

We will then investigate how fossils have given us an insight into the past and how living things have adapted to their environment over millions of years.





Maths

Measurement:

We will continue to recap and further develop our understanding of all 4 operations in different contexts including fractions, decimals and percentages; the children will learn how to calculate percentages. Next, we will look at measurements including how to convert between different units with mass, volume, length and time. We will then look at shape including the different feature's of shape and calculating area, perimeter and angles.

The children will be focusing on making inferences, justifying them with evidence from the text, as well as summarising what they have read and asking questions to help them understand it further. We will also practice our comprehension skills across a range of texts, linked to our foundation subjects, to build reading stamina.

Home Learning

This half term the children will be set a project linked to our current learning on Evolution in Science which they will have a number of weeks to complete.

Throughout the term, children will also be given spelling, grammar and reading tasks to enhance and embed their learning, as well as Math Shed Assignments and rehearsal of their times tables, using Times Table Rockstars.

PSHE & Music

PSHE:

In PSHE this half term, we will be following our Jigsaw scheme of work and our topic is 'Healthy Me'. The children will consider how they can be responsible for their own health, both physical and mental health. They will learn strategies to cope with stress and pressures and know what can be harmful for them.

Music:
